	7.1	<p>PC Trish Attwood presented the report.</p> <p>The bicycle provided by the Parish Council will continue to be held at Romsey police station where it will be maintained and still used to patrol Nursling & Rownhams.</p> <p>It is hoped to re-introduce Beat Surgeries but the weekly Beat Report will be replaced by an online website HampshireAlert.</p> <p>Test Valley police will continue to cover Nursling & Rownhams with a Team stationed at Romsey. 6 PCSOs will cover Nursling & Rownhams, Chilworth and North Baddesley. The police have 4 key fobs available for access to the Village Hall.</p> <p>Anti-Social behaviour has reduced but there are still problems on Adanac Park. There was a burglary by 2 males in a house along Romsey Road. A number of cars have been damaged and one car torched in Coldharbour Lane.</p> <p>Action at Rownhams Service station includes charges for drug offences, cars seized for no insurance but cars are still filling with fuel and driving off without paying whilst thefts including tyres are also occurring.</p>
