This was not on the list of Planning Applications but was brought to the attention of the Council due to an objection and closing date to inform TVBC. The PA was discussed and an agreed Objection to be logged with TVBC due to size of extension, overlooking neighbour's property, out of character to over properties, no increase in parking, effect on street scene.	
	14.2	<b>16/00214/FULLS – 5 St Johns Glebe.</b> Single storey front & rear extension. New pitched lean to roof over garage. This has also appeared after the Agenda produced. The Parish Council have looked at the Planning Application and would be placing an objection to TVBC due to the plans not being to scale and not professionally produced, out of character with the street scene, the increased driveway and extension could affect drainage and roots of nearby TPO trees, could cause problems for the adjoining neighbours flat roof garage.
