The basis of their challenge was as follows:- <ul> <li>The Plan does not provide sufficient housing to meet the objectively assessed housing need.</li> <li>The Council failed to co-operate with neighbouring authorities to meet its housing need.</li> <li>The Plan failed to provide sufficient employment and commercial land to meet its identified need.</li> </ul> </li> <li>The Trustees have also challenged the Inspector's decision regarding the planning appeal on land at Adanac, Nursling. This was heard at the same time.</li> </ul>
