**TV632 – Romsey Road Roundabout, Nursling – Carriageway Resurfacing**

As part of Operation Resilience, Hampshire County Council's programme to make Hampshire's roads more resilient to the effects of extreme weather and heavy traffic, this letter is to advise of upcoming carriageway resurfacing works on Romsey Road roundabout, Nursling.

The works are programmed to start 24<sup>th</sup> September 2020 and are expected to last for 8 nights, during which time the roundabout, the M271 north of junction 3, and A3057 Southampton Road north of the Romsey Road roundabout will be closed to vehicular traffic, from 20:00 to 06:00 hrs each night. The roads will be open during the day and weekends.

The above timescales are weather dependent, any significant changes to the scheduled dates will be made clear on the yellow sign boards located at the works limits.

Due to the current COVID-19 situation, works will be carried out ensuring safe working practices, and social distancing between site operatives and members of the public are maintained at all times. The appropriate traffic management will be in place to prevent any interaction

In order to help us to complete the work as quickly as possible, please ensure that no vehicles are parked on the road or in the laybys on the days of the resurfacing. **Please be aware any vehicles left parked on the road that prevent the works taking place, face the risk of being removed.**
